Along with designated Nazarene Approved Missions Project giving (formerly known as Mission Specials), **World Evangelism Fund (WEF) gifts are essential to every part of our global ministry.**

It is important to note that most Nazarene Approved Missions Projects are funded by donor-designated giving. This means these funds are passed through to the field without taking out administrative costs. Therefore, World Evangelism funds are used to pay for the costs of administering those programs throughout the globe. **World Evangelism giving is the foundation for everything the Lord is doing through the global Church of the Nazarene.**

Our core method of missions through compassion, evangelism, and education are accomplished by the following ministry areas that are funded with World Evangelism giving.

Global Missions functions, including:

- Salaries and benefits for 325+ missionaries on global deployment, plus infrastructure for nearly 150 missionaries on sponsored deployment.
- Missionary engagement, equipping, and training.
- Ministry support and funding for six regional offices (Africa, Asia-Pacific, Eurasia, Mesoamerica, South America, and USA/Canada).
- Ministry support allocations for 37 fields that report to the regional offices.
- Ministry support allocations for many start-up districts.
- Global publications, including translation of evangelism and discipleship materials.
- Administrative/back office support for ministries supported by the designated giving of Nazarene Approved Missions Projects. This includes support for Work & Witness, Alabaster, World Mission Broadcast, Global Missions field partnerships, and more.
- Global Missions support staff at the Global Ministry Center.

Your generosity through **World Evangelism giving reaches far beyond just supporting our missionary movement.** It also supports the following:

Events to encourage denominational connection and theological coherence, including General Assemblies, Mid-Quadrennial (“M-Conferences”), district leaders’ events, General Board meetings, theology conferences, etc.

Global Nazarene Missions International (NMI), including costs for the operation of the Global NMI Council.

Global Nazarene Youth International (NYI), including costs for:

- Operation of the Global NYI Council.
- Grants for the functioning of global NYI regions.
- Event planning services for Nazarene Youth Conference (on all regions) and Third Wave events.

Global Nazarene Discipleship Ministries International (NDI), including costs for global discipleship resourcing, operation of the Global NDI Council, lay training programs, and children's ministry (including quizzing resources).

Global Ministry of the Board of General Superintendents, including costs for global travel for district assemblies, ordinations, etc.

Global Education and Clergy Development, including costs for:

- Oversight for 50+ seminaries and universities, including funding for the International Course of Study Advisory Committee (ICOSAC).
- Development and administration of ordination requirements for global clergy.
- Support allocations for Nazarene Theological Seminary, Nazarene Bible College, and Nazarene Theological College – Manchester.
- Support/maintenance for the Wesleyan-Holiness Digital Library (WHDL), which is used by most Nazarene educational institutions.
- Administrative work for PALCONs

Administrative functions, including:

- Finance, accounting, and Donor Services.
- Governance/statistical data
- Human Resources
- Information Technology
- Global Communications
- Stewardship Development
- Event Services
- Nazarene Archives
- Nazarene Research Services
- General Counsel/Legal
- Insurance/Risk Mitigation

Another important note: An endowment is now in place that will pay for the entire building operation costs of the Global Ministry Center, including all utilities and the maintenance, repair, and upkeep of the building, landscaping, and parking lots. This makes available nearly \$1 million of annual World Evangelism funds that were previously needed to maintain the headquarters building that can now be deployed into ministry each year.
